

It's Good News from God!

So, What is the Gospel?



1) Jesus came to show us how much God loves us.

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life (John 3:16)."

Many who believe in God think that He has judged and forsaken them. The truth is that He loves us even when we're undeserving of His love.

2) In Jesus, we have forgiveness of sins.

"In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace (Ephesians 1:7)."

God's no longer looking at our sins, failures, or regrets. He's cleansed us of them through Jesus' blood.

3) In Jesus, we become brand new people reconciled back to God.

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:17, 18)."

We can become new people, and have a brand new start with God helping us.

4) In Jesus, we have life abundantly.

"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly (John 10:10)."

This life includes blessings on this earth, but more importantly, it's a life filled with peace, joy, and blessings that come from being right with God.

5) In Jesus, we are more than conquerors.

"Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us (Rom 8:35-37)."

There is no evil we face in this life that we can't overcome by faith in Jesus, because whatever is born of God overcomes the world (1 John 5:4).

6) In Jesus, we have authority as children of God.

"But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name (John 1:12)."

When we receive Jesus, we receive the authority to become children of God. As children, we now have rights that include deliverance, healing, and answers to prayer.

7) In Jesus, we have an inheritance reserved in Heaven for us.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you (1 Peter 1:3, 4)."

Jesus came because of YOU, so that you might have an abundant, perpetual life. A life filled with peace, joy, freedom, and victory over the evil in this life. A life that doesn't start after nor finish when you are dead.

But none of this is automatic. It's by believing in Jesus, and by believing in His name. However, you'll only go as far in the new life that God's offering you as you're willing to go. There are no shortcuts. The Good News that's been shared with you is only for those who really want it; who really believe that it's true; who will humble themselves, submit their lives to Jesus, and accept Him as their Lord and Savior.

Is that You? If it is then pray this prayer, right now, with all of your heart:

Jesus, I believe with all my heart that You died on the cross for my sins, and that You were raised from the dead, just as the Bible says. Right now, I ask you to forgive me of my sins, and come into my life, and become my Savior and my Lord. I believe with all my heart that You have heard me, and have forgiven me. Father, God, this means that I've been now made Your child, and that I am now right with You. From this moment forward, I believe that I am a brand new person, and that I have been given a brand new life. Thank you for sending Jesus and for accepting me into Your family. In Jesus' name, Amen.
